Activities will mostly include inventory work using a variety of cruising techniques, reforestation surveys, PCT layout and compliance, marking timber sale stream buffers and unit boundaries, road inspection & road inventory, and other duties assigned by AFM foresters. The position is flexible with starting and end dates to accommodate class schedules. The duration of the summer work schedule would be approximately three months. Work will occur on properties ranging from the Washington coast to the Cascades and will at times require overnight stay.
