MISSION: "To manage Turner lands in an economically sustainable and ecologically sensitive manner, while promoting native species and their habitats."

Vermejo Park Ranch (VPR), comprising 560,000 acres in northern New Mexico and southern Colorado, is seeking a forester to manage its 400,000 acres of forested lands.

Primary responsibilities:

Approximately 60% of the Forester's time will be spent in the field on a variety of tasks including but not limited to timber and firewood harvest layout and harvest supervision, prescribed fire implementation, wildland fire suppression and various forest product inventories. Approximately 40% of the Forester's time will be spent in the office planning timber and firewood harvests, prescribed fires, and producing and submitting the supporting plans and permit applications for these programs to the state of New Mexico. The successful applicant will also administer forest products production and sale, contracted forest products harvesting and a potential carbon sequestration program.

Experience and Education Requirements:

Applicants must have a BS in Forestry or a related field with one years- experience and some training in wildland fire suppression and/or prescribed fire.
