Non-Fire positions will be open for 15 DAYS,

The Inyo National Forest anticipates hiring temporary (1039 hours) positions for the 2020 field season, which require applications to be submitted in September of 2019 for the 2020 temporary hire of seasonal work. A wide variety of trails, maintenance and visitor information assistant positions are available. These outreach announcements are being circulated to inform prospective applicants of Federal employment opportunities. These positions are located at various offices and stations throughout the forest (Lee Vining, CA; Mammoth Lakes, CA; Bishop, CA and Lone Pine, CA).

Please help us in spreading the word as this is a great way to become familiar with opportunities to join the Federal Service.

All positions may not be filled. Hiring is based on the availability of funds. Advertisement of a position is no a guarantee the position will be filled.

Located in California's beautiful Eastern Sierra in Inyo and Mono counties, the Inyo National Forest in Mono County is the east gateway to Yosemite and Inyo County is the west gateway to Death Valley. Mono/Inyo Counties offer clean air, crystal blue skies, mountain lakes and streams, challenging trails, high mountain peaks and beautiful views. Inyo County has the lowest and the highest points in the continental United States. Death Valley National Park (Elevation -282 below sea level) is 105 miles east and Mt. Whitney (Elevation 14,497) is 14 miles to the west of Lone Pine. With over two million acres, the Inyo National Forest is home to many natural wonders including Mt. Whitney, Mono Lake, Mammoth Lakes Basin and the Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest. More than 800,000 acres are in nine Congressionally-designated Wilderness Areas. Diverse geologic features, combined with the elevation, extremes produces a wide range of climatic conditions resulting in tremendous floristic diversity on the Forest, with vegetation communities ranging from desert scrub, sagebrush scrub and Pinyon woodland, to Jeffrey Pine, Lodgepole pine and alpine habitats. Both counties are high-use recreation-oriented resort areas with a full range of winter and summer outdoor recreation. These opportunities include backpacking, fishing, hunting, hang gliding, cross-country skiing, downhill skiing, cycling, mountain biking, photography, rock climbing and horseback riding.

To apply for these temporary jobs you will need to apply through the USAJobs website - https://www.USAJOBS.gov. APPLY ONLINE at www.USAJOBS.gov

Step 1: Create a USAJobs account (if you do not already have one) at www.USAJOBS.gov. It is recommended that, as part of your profile, you set up automatic email notification to be informed when the status of your application changes. If you choose not to set up this automatic notification, then you will have to log into your USAJOBS account to check on the status of your application.

Step 2: Create a resume with USAJOBS, or upload a resume into your USAJOBS account. You may want to customize your resume to ensure it documents your past duties and accomplishments directly related to that position, so your application will meet required qualifications.

Step 3: Search for the job announcement number. (Note: Questions regarding a specific position or office/station location should be directed to the contact name listed in the table). You can update your application or documents anytime while the announcement is open. Simply log into your USAJOBS account and click on "Application Status". Click on the position title and then select "Update Application" to continue.
