Job Description:

- Lead outdoor education programs and support stewardship in a nature park, rich with plant diversity and wildlife.
- Assist with the coordination and delivery of Service Learning field trips for grades 3-12. Teach outdoor education curriculum, often connected to on-site, community service projects including trail maintenance, weed removal and habitat restoration.
- Assist in the training and support of a large volunteer community, through volunteer program coordination, training, appreciation and the development of volunteer handbook.
- Assist with habitat maintenance and restoration projects in both natural habitats and demonstration flower gardens.

Scope of Position:

This 6-month position runs February 1, 2023 to July 31, 2023. Pay/benefits include a \$9,001 living allowance paid over the 6-month service term (approx. \$1,500 monthly, before taxes). An education stipend of \$3,247.50, basic medical insurance, childcare allowance, professional development and extensive training opportunities.

Apply by Jan 13, 2023. Interviews are conducted on a rolling basis, early application encouraged.
