ROSEBURG JOB DESCRIPTION (2 positions available)

2. Hands on Silviculture (40%) – hack & squirt of hardwoods, backpack spraying, etc...
3. Logging administration work (20%) – Stream buffer layout and harvest unit layout.
4. Chance to work in other departments within the company.

MEDFORD JOB DESCRIPTION (2 positions available)

1. Hands on Silviculture (60%) – hack & squirt of hardwoods, backpack spraying, etc...
2. Inventory (30%) – collection of tree & stand measurements to determine future actions.
3. Special Projects (10%) – chance to broaden your knowledge on other forestry activities.

WAGES: Interns will be paid \$14 to \$17 per hour depending on experience. Lone Rock Interns are also eligible for up to a \$1,000 Bonus divided in 3 separate payments.
