The USDA Forest Service, Mt. Hood National Forest is seeking to fill a variety of 1039 temporary positions in our **East Zone Recreation Program** for the 2024 field season. The East Zone of the Forest includes the Hood River Ranger District based in Parkdale, OR and the Barlow Ranger District based in Dufur, OR. **The duty station for these positions will be the Parkdale Work Center in Parkdale, OR.**



Seasonal positions will be focused in either the developed recreation, non-motorized trails or off-highway vehicle program and are limited to 1,039 hours during the year. Employees work across the broader recreation program and Zone to support other priority projects as well. Bunkhouse style housing **may** be available at the Parkdale Work Center. **Interested candidates should contact Jon for more information or to express interest in these seasonal employment opportunities.**

Developed Recreation: educate Forest visitors, maintain rec site facilities, install signs/information kiosks, clean bathrooms, patrol dispersed recreation sites, trailheads and campgrounds

Trails: maintain non-motorized and wilderness trails on foot using chainsaws, crosscut saws, loppers, McLeods, Pulaskis, motorized toters, and other hand and power tools

Off-Highway Vehicles (OHV): patrol motorized trails on dirt bike, ATV or UTV, build trails using mini-excavators or mini dozers, enforce OHV regulations, and clear trails using chainsaws
