Overview

Description

Rayonier is filling intern positions with Sophomore, Junior, Senior and Graduate-level students for employment during the summer of 2026.

Interns will have the opportunity to participate in the steps of timber harvesting and regeneration. There will be exposure to the Washington Forest Practices Act and SFI. Unit layout, stream delineation, harvest application preparation, and road engineering will all be a part of the position. You will be given the opportunity to gain independence and grow while being supported by industry experts. We expect this position to help you gain a well rounded understanding of industrial timberland operations.

Personal transportation to and from the office is required, during work hours a pickup will be provided.

Housing assistance (\$800/ Month total for internship), cell phone (one-time payment of \$120) and safety boot reimbursement available, if required

Requirements:

- Students will be paid according to their class standing for the Fall of 2026, Sophomore (\$19.80/hr) Junior (\$21.75/hr), Senior (\$23/hr) or Graduate studies (\$24.50/hr)
- Degree Concentration – Forest Management, Forest Engineering, Forest Operations, Forestry
- Each internship duration will last ten to twelve weeks.
- Candidates should be self-motivated.
- Able to work independently in remote locations.
- Able to endure the elements (rain & uneven terrain)
