Resilient Forestry works in all aspects of forestry, forest science, and forest management, specializing in ecological forest restoration. We are based in Seattle and work across the Pacific Northwest (PNW) with small and large public and private landowners on a range of projects.

What We are Looking For

We are looking for folks who are comfortable working in the field to lead small teams collecting data in forests across Washington and Oregon during the 2022 field season. You will work with Project Managers to organize and execute field projects. This will be a full-time seasonal position. Start and end dates are flexible (February-March and August-October). Workload will vary up to 40 hrs/wk. This position requires significant travel: likely 80-100% of weeknights will be spent away from home, often camping in the woods. \$20-22/hr with mileage and per diem. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis.

Qualifications

- Forestry- or ecology-focused college education in progress or completed
- 1-2 seasons of experience collecting data in forests, preferably in the PNW
- Experience or openness to leading small teams
- Organized; ability to manage collected data and maintain team schedule
- A working understanding of PNW ecosystems
- Positive attitude and ability to lead an inclusive work environment
- Ability to travel, work, and camp in rough terrain and adverse conditions
- Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle capable of driving on primitive roads
