### **Company Profile:**

Pacific Ghost Forestry Services, Inc. is a privately owned forest management firm operating in the heart of the Pacific Northwest. We specialize in working with medium-large forestland owners/managers providing solutions for timber inventories, forestland valuations and comprehensive harvest operation support. As we continue to grow, we are looking to add talented individuals to our team.

### **Job Description:**

- The vast majority of time in this position will be spent cruising timber. The candidate can expect to spend a considerable amount of time navigating across landscapes via GPS to predetermined “plots” in the field. At each plot, data to measure and collect will usually include (but not be limited to) tree counts, species, diameters, heights, damage, etc.
- Other activities may include harvest unit layout, management plan preparation, managing reforestation crews, digital mapping (GIS) and/or inventory database management.
- Starting date is flexible, though it is likely the chosen candidate will need to start by April 1, 2025.

### **Compensation:**

Pay structure will vary depending on the activity being done on any given day. Hourly pay, when appropriate, will be \$25/hr. Production rate pay will vary by job but will never be less than \$25/hr. under normal circumstances. When in use, any production pay rates will be clearly stated prior to the start of any new projects.

Benefits include paid federal holidays. Additionally, paid time off will be given in accordance with laws of the state the candidate resides in. If the position becomes permanent, health and retirement benefits will also be offered.

## Requirements:

- Work is 90%+ in the field in often steep, brushy, remote forestlands. Additionally, work is done in all but the most extreme weather conditions. Applicant must be physically fit and able to orient, climb and travel over harsh topography for long periods of time, all while maintaining a mental capacity to measure and collect accurate data.
- Must be comfortable working alone in the field with little to no supervision. Beyond the physical conditions of the field, applicant must be comfortable with chance encounters with wildlife, insects and reptiles.
- As the work will occur throughout the northwest, travel for extended periods of time will be necessary. The majority of work will occur in western Oregon and western Washington, though other regions may be possible.
- Prior experience is NOT necessary, but preference may be given to applicants with similar experience and/or those who have worked in similar field conditions.
- Applicant will be required to collect and maintain highly accurate datasets and periodically deliver data to a supervisor via digital transmission or physical meet-up.
- Preference will be given to applicants with a trusted, reliable 4-wheel drive vehicle. A vehicle use/fuel reimbursement will be given in addition to pay. Reimbursement will be based on miles driven while working.
- Applicant will be expected to be punctual and available to work full-time, though the hours may be flexible.
- Applicant will be expected to adhere to a strict safety protocol and check-in/out procedure daily.
- Applicant may periodically meet with contract administrators, at which time they will be expected to be professional, courteous and act as a positive representative of the Company.
