Description

Rayonier is interested in filling an intern position out of our Hoquiam, Washington office for 12 weeks in the summer of 2020. Starting and ending dates are flexible. Rates are \$17/hour for juniors, \$18 for seniors, and \$19 for graduate level. We also provide housing allowance if needed: \$600/month max of \$1,800 for the duration of the internship. Cell phone usage max \$120 one-time payment for field interns. Safety boot reimbursement up to \$200.

Operational Interns will be exposed to field reconnaissance, GIS software, map making, photo interpretation, data recorders, and field measurement techniques and tools. They may also be involved with timber sales, forest engineering, and silvicultural planning. Interns will receive a well-rounded view of Rayonier operations by spending time with representatives from each department.

- Students in their Junior, Senior year or Graduate studies
- Degree Concentration Forest Management or related field
- Provide personal, reliable transportation capable of driving forest roads (preferred)
- Candidates should be self-motivated
- Able to work independently in remote locations
- Able to work in all weather conditions and on uneven terrain
