

## 2022 Summer Internships Hoquiam & Chehalis, WA

## Overview

## Description

Rayonier is filling intern positions with Sophmore, Junior, Senior and Graduate-level students for employment during the summer of 2023.

**Interns** will have the opportunity to work with both our engineering and production departments. The time spent with the engineering department will include time doing unit layout and contract compliance on road construction and fish passage culvert projects.

The production department experience will include logging contractor compliance and gaining familiarity with log sorts.

Skills learned will include an introduction to the Washington Forest Practice Act and SFI.

## Requirements:

- Students in their Sophmore (\$19/hr) Junior (\$21.50/hr), Senior (\$23/hr) or Graduate studies (\$24.50/hr)
- Degree Concentration Forest Management, Forest Engineering
- Each internship duration will last ten to twelve weeks.
- Candidates should be self-motivated
- Able to work independently in remote locations
- Able to endure the elements (rain & uneven terrain)
