ABOUT THE OUTREACH:

The United States Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Oregon/Washington (OR/WA) State Office will be filling a permanent, full time forest analyst position (professional forester, GS-460-13). The vacancy announcement will be advertised soon through USAJOBS (<u>www.usajobs.gov</u>).

ABOUT THE POSITION:

This position is the senior technical expert for strategic forest resource analysis, forest dynamics modeling, and data management. The incumbent takes on high-level and controversial planning projects for the development and implementation of resource management plans (RMPs), the BLM's strategic plans for managing natural resources. The position plays a unique role in the organization by combining diverse skills and knowledge bases, including forest policy, strategic planning, data management, and mathematical modeling. The incumbent will help guide development of land use plans and lead efforts to collect and analyze the underlying data, and works closely with subject matter experts, technical specialists, planners, attorneys, and managers. The position is critical to the strategic planning the BLM must complete to meet its statutory obligations under multiple statutes.
