The City Nature East program stewards and restores 45 properties on the east side of the Willamette River, applying adaptive ecological principles; developing community partnerships and relationships; and promoting community stewardship of natural areas. The team tends these lands with natural resource needs, biodiversity value, equity and equitable access, climate resilience, and nature-based recreation at the forefront.

Position Overview:

- Plan, supervise, support, and direct the work of a skilled team of 3 Natural Resource Ecologists, 5 Botanic Technicians, and 1-3 to PT Seasonal Maintenance Workers.
- Provide day-to-day support, advocacy, and coordination for staff, working to elevate and amplify their needs and concerns and provide needed resources, training, and information.
- Apply the Parks Equity Lens and other Bureau tools and resources to advance racial equity in the unit, the division, and the Bureau.
- Collaborate and coordinate closely with other Parks Bureau units/divisions, City Bureaus, community organizations, and public agencies on complex natural area projects and challenges.
- Answer questions and concerns from the public, providing strong customer service and a solutions-oriented approach.
