LAND MANAGEMENT TECHNICIAN – FIREWISE PROJECT

This Land Management Technician position works primarily in support of the <u>Firewise Incentive</u> <u>Project</u> within Long Range Planning. Duties entail a mix of field and office work, including conducting basic site inspections; processing grant applications; and performing education and outreach efforts related to natural hazards mitigation as it applies to land use. Position also performs other duties as assigned related to planning, building, and/or compliance program assistance. <u>NOTE</u>: This is a limited duration position, subject to the availability of funding, estimated to be likely one–two years in length.

REQUIREMENTS: Listed directly below are the minimum requirements for this position.

- Equivalent to the completion of two years of college level coursework in drafting, land surveying, urban planning, construction, or a related field.
- > One year of paraprofessional planning or building experience.

Applicants with an equivalent combination of experience and training that demonstrate the required knowledge and abilities is also qualifying.
