

Log Procurement Specialist Eugene, Oregon

Key responsibilities:

Overall implementation of Northwest Hardwoods log and timber sale acquisition program to augment the log purchasing program supplying raw materials to our sawmills in Oregon. This position will report to Western Regional Raw Materials Manager.

The successful candidate will focus on identifying more timber and log acquisition opportunities for log supply to the sawmills in Oregon. The position will require traveling the foothills of the Cascades, Willamette Valley, Coast Range, Northern California as well as various NWH locations. The position will also include a review of land cover types and ownership status of forest land of interest, usually with significant hardwood supply potential. The position will make use of aerial photography to identify tracts that warrant on the ground inspection and owner contact for log or timber purchasing. This position will be based at the Eugene OR location.

Requirements:

- Two Year Associates Degree in Forestry or related field or 2 or more years of experience in the Pacific Northwest procuring logs, buying timber, scaling, or working in the Timber industry
- Knowledge of log and lumber grades as well as value extraction fundamentals
- Strong computer skills in Microsoft Office with working knowledge of timber cruising tools
- Excellent analytical skills
- Well developed negotiation skills
- Knowledge of timber harvest systems
- Ability to work safely
- Strong skills in problem solving, ability to work through conflict
- Excellent interpersonal skills, strong communication skills written and oral
- Ability to develop peer-to-peer relationships and work as part of a team
- Self-motivated, able to work unsupervised and is task oriented
