Elevations on the District range from sea level at Sand Lake Recreation area to 3,140 feet at the top of Mount Hebo. The community of Hebo, Oregon lies about halfway between Tillamook and Lincoln City on the scenic Oregon coast. Both are full-service communities within 25 miles of Hebo on Highway 101. Hebo has miles of sandy ocean beaches, forest roads, hiking trails, and a picturesque bay. This is the coast treasured by Oregonians. Hebo and the surrounding area offer fishing, crabbing, biking, hiking, sailing, and more.

**Seasonal housing may be available located 25 miles north of Reedsport, OR.** The 479,000-acre Central Coast Ranger District-Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area (CCRD-ODNRA) extends from Newport, OR in the north-to-North Bend, OR in the south; from the Pacific Ocean to the crest of the coast range mountains (just west of Corvallis and Eugene). The Siuslaw’s coastal influence, ocean-forest interface, relatively young Douglas-fir forest, and cultural history make it unique. The Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area is located on the Oregon Coast, stretching approximately 40 miles north of the Coos River in North Bend to the Siuslaw River in Florence, and adjoining Honeyman State Park on the West.
